

**ESA Minnesota State Meeting
Ridgedale Library, Minnetonka
September 18, 2021**

Call to Order: President Sandy Hongerholt called the meeting to order, and the Opening Ritual was recited.

- Motion to distribute Medtox Foundation money of \$2222.50 be distributed directly to ESA Foundation for the following areas:
 - \$1500.00 to Vocational Training Grants
 - \$722.50 to MN State Endowment Scholarship

•Vocational Training Grants: For those seeking to develop skills for a new career or enhance their skills and knowledge in advancement of chosen career field such as completing requirements to obtain a trade certification or apprenticeships (cosmetology, welding, plumbing, electricians, mechanics). I.e. Veterans looking to re-enter the workforce needing training in their field of interest. Also for promoting programs and skills for training in the fine arts and those who are developing creative programs or projects that use elements of the fine arts to benefit returning military personnel.

•Career Enhancement Grants: To develop skills for career advancement through training programs to update or maintain employment credentials
